DSM-IV-TR multi-axial system. With the advent of the DSM-5 in 2013, the APA eliminated the longstanding multi-axial system for mental disorders. Previously, the DSM-IV organized each psychiatric diagnosis into five dimensions (axes) that related to different aspects of disorder or disability:

Note: Individuals with a well-established DSM-IV diagnosis of autistic disorder, Asperger's disorder, or pervasive developmental disorder not otherwise specified should be given the diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder.
